Daily Events:

The day begins with daily assembly which consists of devotional song, reading from the Holy Scripture a prayer, daily news, thought for the day etc., which enable the student to improve their ethical consciousness and create healthy mind in healthy body.

We are fortunate to have a cadre of twenty teachers well trained, well experienced, dedicated and capable of full filling the demands of the growing modern generation of students and a committed band of non teaching staff.

Infrastructure

The school has good infrastructure with the better facilities. Our school is environmental friendly for the children to learn in a peaceful and healthy environment. The children have spacious play ground for their physical education.

Here is a new venture in the expansion of school premises that is an entrance Arch which magnetize very beautifully.

We have a well equipped computer lab with **20** computers for the children to get well versed in computer application. We too have a library with **1600 books** for the students to enhance their knowledge

There are science and math lab for IX standard students for their practical and manual activities, which helps for demonstration to have practical knowledge.

The SMS software is introduced to convey the emergency and necessary information to the parents on their mobile which makes the communication easier.

In this academic year the smart class is established in four rooms and the CBSE curriculum software is installed for smart learning. This educational software helps the teacher and students to accomplish the subject task with detailed information.

Apart from the various course subjects teachers we have an enthusiastic team of co curricular activity teachers for physical education, music, dance, art and graft, karate, yoga etc.,

This helps in exploring and nurturing in the innate talents and skills of our promising students.

Current Academic year Activities

Last year we had **460 students** enrolled and this year this had gone **up to 538**. We are constantly striving to improve this.

To make more confident in spoken English, the special ELT (English Language

Teaching) class is arranged for secondary students. The English master guides the students to improve their speaking skill and listening skill from the month of August onwards.

The slow learners were identified and the remedial classes were arranged to give close attention to them in order to strengthen their basic knowledge and to focus the subject enrichment



To build up the future citizens with social values and moral ethics, we impart and insist the value education.



Every Thursday and Saturday is allotted for the different activities such as, Karate, Yoga, Vocal, Keyboard, Dance, to develop their mental capacity. Hence it is known as 'Activity Day'. We believe this will help in the more Holistic development of our students.

Our school is constituted into four houses such as blue, pink, red and yellow to make the students disciplined. The captains and vice captains had taken oath and were given roles and responsibility to take care of the discipline and rules of the school.



Staff enrichment program

Teachers are always learners. Staying updated is the key to success and so our teaching staff constantly strive to stay updated by attentive workshops and various training programmes . For an exposure and cross learning, the senior class teachers had gone to Mont ford Public School, Sivagangai.

One day seminar was organized for the teachers on 15th May 2018. Bro. Gomos MF the principal of Mont ford Public School, Sivangangai and Mr. Dhayalan guided the teachers on "Assessment structure and Multiple intelligence".

Capacity building: On 30th August 2018 Sr. Janci Rani, the principal attended two days Induction program for school managers and principals in Chennai which was organized by Center of Excellence the training institute of CBSE Board.

A one day workshop was conducted by educational software providers i:e NIIT nguru and Extramarks India PVT Ltd and Macmillan book publishers.

Sports and cultural competitions:

21 children have participated Taluk level Karate competition in KCM School at Nilakottai on 03.02.18, which was organized by Hirosin Rio karate Association. Among the participants 8 of them have got Gold, 7 of them got silver and 6 of them have got bronze medals.

In universal shotokan karate held India at Thirupur on 18en February 2018. Two students got Gold Medals, two got Silver medals and three got bronze medals.

The District level karate Tournament held at Dindigul on 21st July 2018.

The children won 4 Gold medals, 2 silver medals and 4 bronze medals.

In South India level Karate Tournament held at Dindigul District on 19en august 2018. Students got hold of 4 gold medals 4 silver medals.



In order to strengthen the innovative skills and talents our school encouraged the students to participate in the drawing, handwriting and essay writing which is organized by Talent exam, Selam, Metur Anai on 02nd July 2018, 01st August 2018, and 29th August 2018 on the commemoration of educational developmental Day, Independence Day and the Teachers Day.

Maximum children contributed and made the school to be proud. The school got special cultural endeavor award. Four children got first prize and 3 got second prizes and the rest nearly ninety got participation certificate and consolation prizes.

The children participated in Drawing and handwriting competitions in three languages which are organized by Aurangabad institute. Three students got first prize in colouring.

Erode Excel institute organized inter school Gk competition. 60 students participated.

The Boys team consist of 18 members went to Achuda CBSE Senior Secondary school at Dindigul On 04th August 2018 for foot ball tournament organized by MSSC.



The Girls team consist of 10members went to ShrikarraVidhyaMandhir CBSE School at Sivanainthapuram, sattur-Taluk for Sahodaya volley Ball tournament on on 20th August 2018. The team competed with many different experienced schools and reached to semifinal.

Physical Education plays a vital role to ensure essential development of the child. Having special concern on this area our School conducted games and sports events on house wise for the children in month of September. The children who participated and secured their positions were honored with the certificates and medals.



The skill and the knowledge are two side of the same coin in education in this modern era, keeping eye on this special need our School has organized class wise cultural completions in the month of October such as solo song, solo dance, speech, quiz, Fancy Dress and Drawing competitions. The children came up with excellent preparation to illustrate their potentials. Some of them were explored outstanding performance. The shield with certificate was presented to the prize winners.

The CBSE board has proposed the letter writing competition through Post office by using inland. The 50 secondary students were participated. “A letter to Mother land” was the title of the competition.

The inter school competitions were conducted on 02nd November 2018 in Anugraha school, Dindigul. Mr. Kavin won second prize in vegetable painting and Mr. Madavan, Mr. Muhil, Mr. Gri won second prize in tug of war.
